
Homelessness and housing

If you're homeless now or worried you could be in the next 2 months

You need to make a homeless application to Liverpool City Council's Housing Options Service.

They will: Check your eviction notice is valid; Try to help you stay in your home by talking to your landlord; Work with you to find another place to live; Offer you emergency housing.

You're likely to get more help if you have a priority need, for example if you're pregnant, have dependant children, are a care leaver or have been classed as vulnerable (as a result of old age, disability or domestic abuse). All under 18s are classed as priority and can contact Children's Services at Liverpool City Council.
